WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELEASE HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I understand that engaging in these activities may be hazardous, with accompanying risks of personal injury, death, and/or loss or damage to my property. In consideration of my participation in such shooting activities, I, on my own behalf and that of my heirs, successors, representatives, administrators and assigns, hereby:

1. Waive and completely release any and all, past, present or future claims, causes of action, suits, rights, damages, costs, expenses or obligations or demands of any kind whatsoever, I, or anyone on my behalf might have against Westward Ho Adventures, LLC, Cowtown Range and/or Cowtown Management Group, LLC, its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries or successor and their respective officers, directors, servants, employees, agents, representatives and contractors (together "CMG"), for any loss, damage, personal injury, death and/or loss or damage to my property resulting from my participation in such shooting activities;
2. Agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless CMG, from any and all claims by any person, firm, corporation or others, for any damages, loss or claims, of any nature, arising in any way out of my participation in such shooting activities; and
3. Assume all risks associated with such activities and all responsibility for medical expenses, costs and/or other obligations and other losses or injuries to me or in which I may become involved, by reason of my participation in such shooting activities at the aforementioned facility or event.

MY COMMITMENT TO SAFE GUN HANDLING

Anyone who uses a firearm has a responsibility to themselves and others to use the firearm safely. I acknowledge that I am familiar with the basic rules of firearm safety and that those basic rules have been explained to me. I agree to follow all of the basic rules of firearm safety at all times during my use and handling of any firearms. The safe use of firearms dictates that I understand and agree to follow all of these instructions:

- I WILL TREAT EVERY FIREARM AS IF IT WERE LOADED.
- I WILL ALWAYS KEEP THE FIREARM POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.
- I WILL NOT PLACE MY FINGER ON THE TRIGGER OR IN THE TRIGGER GUARD UNLESS AND UNTIL I AM READY TO FIRE.
- I WILL ALWAYS BE AWARE OF MY TARGET AND WHAT IS BEYOND IT AND AROUND IT.
- I WILL ALWAYS WEAR APPROPRIATE EYE AND EAR PROTECTION.
- I WILL ALWAYS BE IN CONTROL OF MY FIREARMS.
- I WILL ALWAYS FOLLOW THE COMMANDS OF THE RANGE SAFETY OFFICER (RSO).
- I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND AND WILL OBEY THE RANGE RULES (shown on Page 2)

I understand these basic rules of firearms safety and I agree to follow them at all times. I further certify that I am over eighteen [18] years of age and have read and understand this Waiver of Liability and have executed this instrument voluntarily on this date, and that I am a legal United States citizen, and am not a prohibited possessor of firearms. I also agree to allow CMG and their vendors/associates to use photos or videos of me for marketing and promotional purposes, without any identifying information. Range Rules and Regulations

1. Follow all firearm safety rules
 - 1) Treat all firearms as if they were loaded
 - 2) Keep your finger off the trigger and out of the trigger guard until ready to fire
 - 3) Never let the muzzle cover anything you are not willing to destroy
 - 4) Be aware of your target and what is beyond and around it
 - 5) Have control of your firearms at all times
2. Hearing protection must be worn at all times while on the range and near bays or platforms. Shooter's glasses or tempered glasses must be worn at all times while inside the firing area. (prescription excepted).
3. Cease fires will be called by a Range Safety Officer (RSO) when appropriate. When people are down range, shooters must back off the firing line and not handle any guns until everyone is back and the firing line is live again. When the firing line is cold, all guns must be unloaded with the action open and magazines removed.
4. Armor piercing, tracer, incendiary, or explosive ammunition is not allowed unless approved by the Range Manager. 5.56x45mm M855 green tip ammunition or other steel core or bi-metal bullets are not allowed when shooting steel targets in bays. Tannerite and other explosive targets are not allowed unless approved by the Range Manager.
5. You may only use target frames, stands and steel targets provided by CMG, except on Action Bay by approval of the Range Manager. Do not shoot at wildlife, cacti, target frames, rocks or anything not an approved target.
6. All fired rounds must impact the backberms (not the rock wall) when using the bays, and the hillsides when using the platforms.
7. Rapid fire must be approved by the Range Manager, automatic fire on Action Bay only and by approval of the Range Manager.
8. Drawing from a holster must be approved by the Range Manager.
9. All firearms must be unloaded with action open except while actively firing or when handgun is in a holster.
10. All firearms must be unloaded and cased or holstered before leaving the firing area or when being transported from a vehicle to the firing area.
11. Only firearms in good working condition are allowed on the firing line (user is held responsible). All firearms are subject to inspection at any time by the Range Manager.
12. No alcoholic beverages, drugs, or persons who have been consuming those items will be allowed on the range or premises. No tobacco use in firing area.
13. Children under the age of 18 must be supervised at all times while on premises. Children under the age of 10 will not be allowed in the firing areas during open range days unless approved by the Range Manager.
